

## Versus Red 2002

Deep red. Intense berry and chocolate aromas. Rich soft palate with berry fruit and spice, with long finish. Great for all occasions.

**in the vineyard :** Trellised vines, grafted onto rootstock R99, R110, 101-14 Mgt in a weathered granite soil with medium clay were used.

**about the harvest:** These vines yielded 10t/ha and were harvested at 24 Å°B at the end of February. Weather during the ripening season was sunny and dry, with the cooling effect of the Atlantic Ocean.

**in the cellar :** Harvested at optimum ripeness. Cool fermentation (20-24Å°C) to preserve fruit flavours and soft tannins. Pressed before end of fermentation for softness and structure. Blended, egg fined and bottled as an everyday drinking, very accessible wine.
