

## Rooiberg Sauvignon Blanc 2003

The typical herbaceous character of the Sauvignon Blanc grape is easily recognised in this steely dry white wine. A good fruit acid provides the backbone for this bold and complex wine.

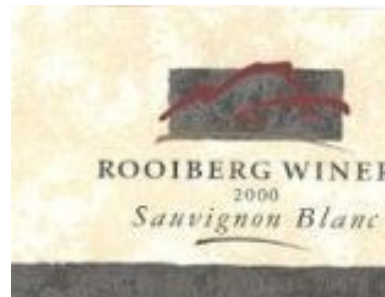
