**in the vineyard** : Soil: All three cultivars are grown on a variety of soil types selected to suit the needs of the vines.

Climate: The Swartland falls within the coastal winter rainfall area. Warm, dry summers, moderated by cool Atlantic breezes.

Annual rainfall: 400mm average.

**about the harvest**: The vineyards that supply the grapes are all grown as unirrigated bush vines and harvested by hand.

**in the cellar** : A Carbonated low alcohol sparkling wine. The blend is made up of three base wines (20% Pinotage, 15% Hanepoot, 65% Chenin Blanc). The wines are carefully selected with the characteristics of the final product in mind. The Pinotage and Hanepoot portions are dry wines made in the usual way and the Chenin Blanc is a natural semi-sweet.
