Production: 8,5 tons per hectare

about the harvest: The grapes were harvested at an average of 25° Balling.

in the cellar : Crushed and destemmed, natural fermentation. Fermented dry on the skins. After alcoholic and MLF racked into 30 % new American oak and 70% in French barrels where it was matured for nine months.
