

## Buitenverwachting Sauvignon Blanc 1999

This light lemon-colored wine is one of the most aromatically beautiful Sauvignon Blancs that South Africa offers. Abundant aromas of green figs, citrus (limes) with hints of gooseberries and flint. An enticing palate – almost Sancerre-like. The mouth teems with elegant acidity and full-bodied richness. Lingered finish. A benchmark example of the cool-climate wines of the Constantia region.
