

Buitenverwachting Sauvignon Blanc 1999

This light lemon-colored wine is one of the most aromatically beautiful Sauvignonâ€™s that South Africa offers. Abundant aromas of green figs, citrus (limes) with hints of gooseberries and flint. An enticing palate â€™ almost Sancerre-like. The mouth teems with elegant acidity and full-bodied richness. Lingered finish. A benchmark example of the cool-climate wines of the Constantia region.
