in the vineyard : Average age of Vine: 10 years

Method of Harvest: Handpicked

Harvest Date: Beginning of March

Climatic region: Paardeberg & Malmesbury

Yield: 6.9 tons per hectare

Soils: Swartland soil form

Altitude: 160 - 180m above sea level

Trellis: 5-wire hedge bushvine

Pruning: Spur pruned

in the cellar : With vinification 75% of the duration of alcoholic fermentation the juice is pumped over the skin cap for colour and flavour extraction. After racking, malolactic fermentation takes place. 60% of the wine is matured with 60% French and 40% American oak.
