about the harvest : Grapes are from selected vineyards. Throughout the valley the terrain enables the winemaker to produce wine with exceptional flavours and drinkability.

in the cellar : After destalking and crushing, the grapes are fermented on the skins under controlled temperatures. Yeast strains are selected to enhance the natural flavours of the grapes.
