Medium to full-bodied, fruity, with a prominent varietal flavour. Soft wood and light tannins are well balanced.

**type :** Red

**ageing :** It is a very drinkable wine and demonstrates good ageing potential.

**in the vineyard :** Climate: Wet winters and warm summers, tempered by cool ocean breezes from over the mountain.

Soil: Weathered granite from Paarl Mountain.

**about the harvest:** Grapes were harvested above 23Å° Balling.

**in the cellar :** The juice was fermented at a high temperature in the beginning to extract flavour and colour and finished at a contrast temperature. The wine was matured in 300 litre French oak barrels for twelve months. No filtration.
