

Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc 1997

A first-rate blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Rhine Reisling and Steen (Chenin Blanc). Unique in character, it is a gorgeous example of the wonderful cool-climate grape-growing in the Cape. This wine is an unwooded, dry white with a fragrant, floral nose. It presents full fruit on the palate and shimmering acidity on the finish.
