

Seidelberg Sauvignon Blanc 2004

A crisp dry white wine with hints of tropical fruit, green peppers and fresh cut grass. Consistently one of the best from the region, this wine typifies the South African "terroir" being neither as flinty as a French Sauvignon nor as overtly fruit driven as a typical "new world" wine.
