

Rozier Bay Cabernet Sauvignon 2003

Bronze - International Wine and Spirit Competition (IWSC) 2005

Full bodied deep purple leads into fine blackberry/cassis aromas with hints of new spicy oak. Warm blackberries and tarry nuances are balanced by silky, elegant tannins.

A tender fillet steak, a lamb shank and game pates would all benefit from such a partner and strong cheeses such as munster should not be served without this.
