Rich, plum and dark chocolate flavours intermingled with delicate clove flavours. Ripe fruit tannins for a structured mouthfeel, succulent and full. Elegant, long finish.

Any full flavoured dishes, meat, pasta or cheese – even baked puddings.

ageing : Will mature in the bottle for a further 8-10 years.

in the vineyard : The Old Road Vineyard planted in 1971, producing 4 tonnes per hectare.

about the harvest: Handpicked in mid-February 2001

in the cellar : After destalking the wine was pumped in to open fermentors with 3 pump downs per day. Fermented dry on the skins at 28°C after 6 days. Malolactic fermentation followed and the wine was then transferred into new French and American Oak barriques for 12 months. A light egg white fining was added before bottling.
